I am requesting funding for the SR-530 Roundabout project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Stillaguamish Tribe, located at 3322 236th St NE, Arlington, WA 98223. The funding would be used for constructing a roundabout at the SR-530 & Smokey Point Blvd in Arlington, WA. These improvements to the SR-530 corridor will help increase employment opportunities, reduce congestion on I-5, and increase safety with a reduction in collisions.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because SR-530 is a critical vehicle and freight corridor connecting north Arlington, Oso, Darrington and northeast Snohomish County to Interstate 5 (I-5). The project will greatly improve safety and mobility on the SR-530 corridor, and will support job growth and home building in Snohomish County.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C 133.
