

## **WA01 Congressional Art Competition: 2026 Size/Framing Rules**

### **Size Restrictions**

Artwork must be two-dimensional. Each framed artwork can be no larger than 26 inches high, 26 inches wide, 4 inches deep, and 15 pounds. If your artwork is selected as the winning piece, it must arrive in Washington, DC, framed. Even when framed, it must still measure no larger than the maximum dimensions.

### **Frame Restrictions**

All artwork must be framed (the only exception is a canvas painting). If you are entering a photograph into the competition, it must be printed and framed.

### **Student Information and Release Form**

A TYPED copy of the Student Information and Release Form, signed by the teacher, a parent or guardian, and the student, must be **securely** attached to the back of the artwork. Please retain a copy for your records.

### **Winning Artwork**

The First-Place winning artwork will have to meet more specific hanging requirements. The winner will be informed of these requirements and expected to complete them before the artwork is mailed to Washington DC in early May.
