I am requesting funding for the Alderwood Mall Parkway: SR525 to 168th St SW in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of Snohomish, located at 3000 Rockefeller Ave. M/S 607, Everett, WA 98201. The funding would be used for Snohomish County to widen the roadway from three to five lanes.
